The event will provide the public an insight into this world class test and evaluation facility through live dynamic firing displays and static displays, such as weapon platforms, watercraft, military vehicles, historic photos, ammunition and a variety of stalls.

P&EE PW was established in 1928 and has conducted regular testing of ammunition since 1929. It is one of only three known locations in the world where testing of this nature can be undertaken. The Establishment is critical to ensuring the safety and availability of weapon systems and explosives ordnance used by Australian Defence Force personnel on operations and during training.

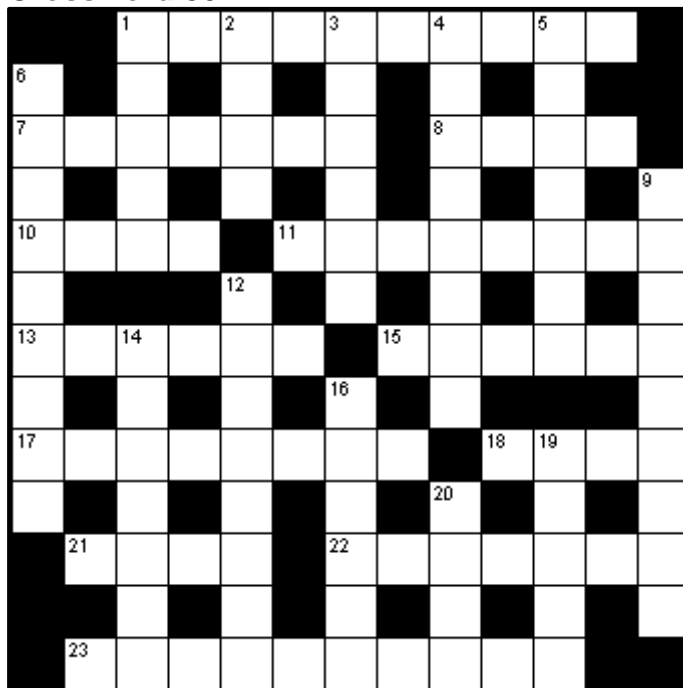

Citizen of the Year 2019

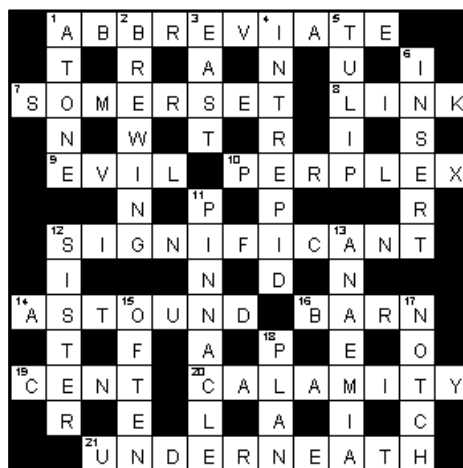
Last time round our Owen-based Adelaide Plains CWA brought home the state level Community Event of the Year award. This year we're expecting some more stella nominations.

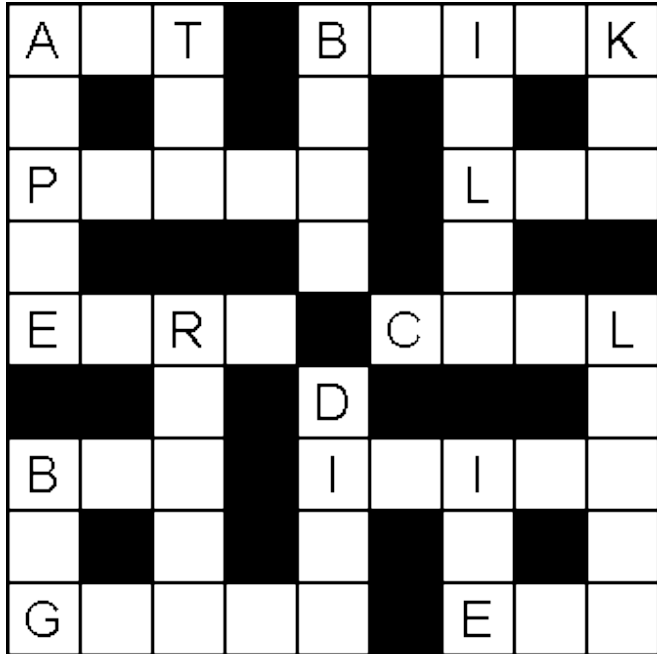

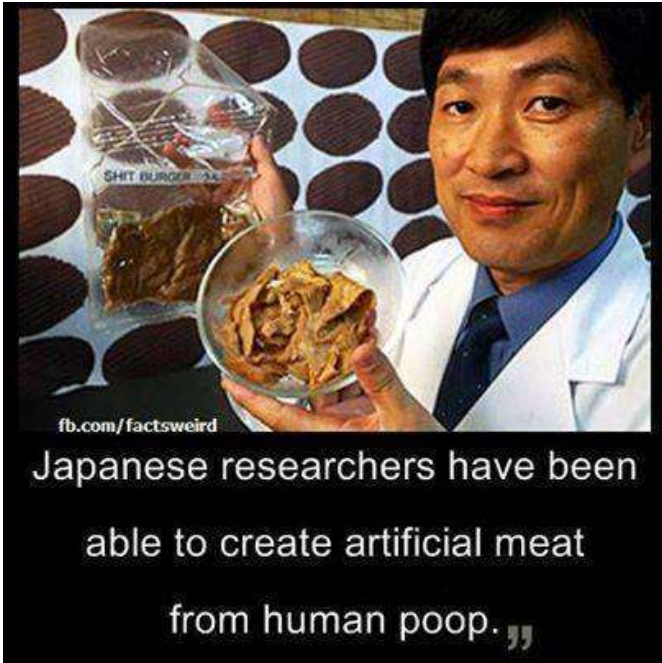
