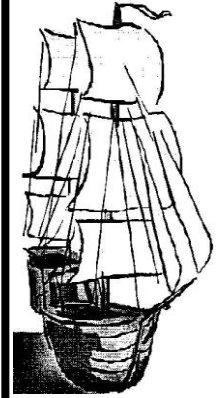

In the Garden 2022 No 2

I was reading a magazine that mentioned edible flowers adding a boost to our health from the plants in our garden.

Nasturtiums are a favourite; the light peppery flavour is refreshing. Most of the plant may be eaten, including the leaves, flowers, and seeds. The seeds may be pickled, and the leaves and flowers shredded and added to a salad to decorate and flavour. They are packed with Vitamin C, Iron, Flavonoids and Beta Carotene.

Roses are a beautiful addition to any garden, and the petals and buds make a pretty decoration for cakes and cocktails. The Rosehips can be used to make Teas, Jam and Syrup. They are packed with healthy Polyphenols and may even help to alleviate stress.

The petals of the Pansy make a gorgeous addition to salads, cakes, and cocktails and have antioxidant and anti-inflammatory properties. As with all flowers, it is important to pick blooms that haven't been exposed to toxic pesticides.

Yesterday's News

The Central Advocate March 1, 1907



PORT WAKEFIELD- The defeat our local tennis club suffered at the hands of the Balaklava Club lately, instead of throwing them in a state of despair, has had the opposite effect to such an extent that an old tennis court has been resurrected, brushed up, and put in splendid working order, being henceforth known as the Standard.

This court saw great play some few years ago and was well protected by huge wire netting on the east side of the oval, became discarded and forgotten, and the posts and material enclosing it became a menace and source of annoyance to the cricketers in the good old days when we had first-class matches here.

This court has of late undergone a transformation scene and has been put in thorough working order, and at daybreak the usual white shoe can be seen making towards the newly enclosed spot, and as the last glimmer of day slowly died away in the west the ping pong of the fishing net and tennis ball could be heard, until the spot had again to be deserted on account of the queer noises being heard amongst the leaves of the lofty gums, and the occasional blaring of a Gem phonograph, situated on the eastern side of the town, which would be followed by other phonographs until as many as half a dozen of these instruments would be blaring forth Edison's records from all points of the compass. 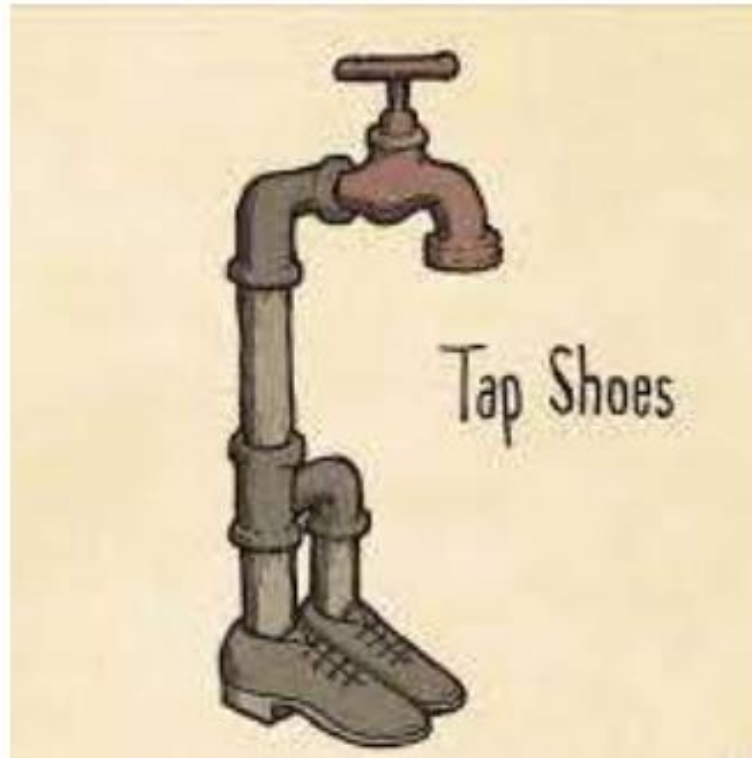

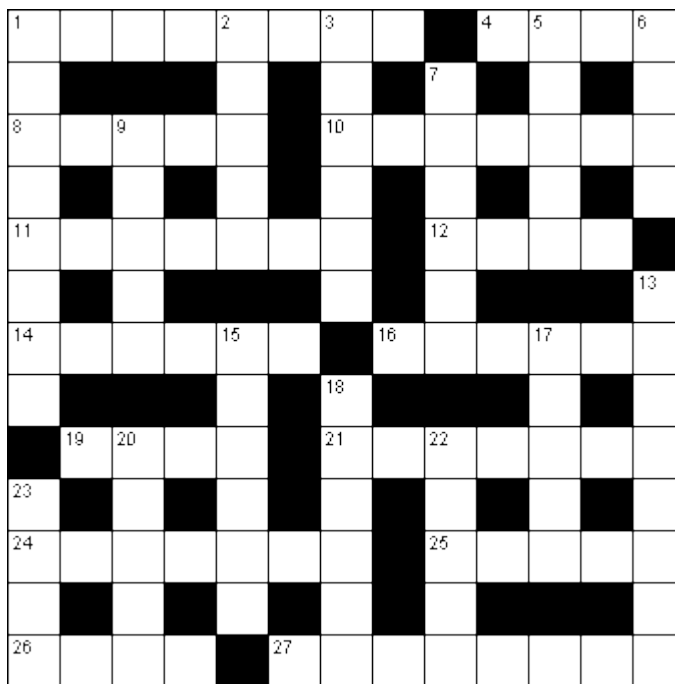
