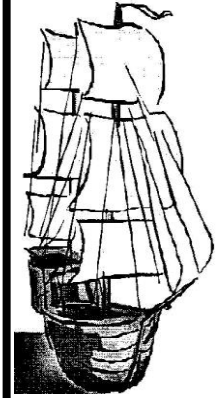

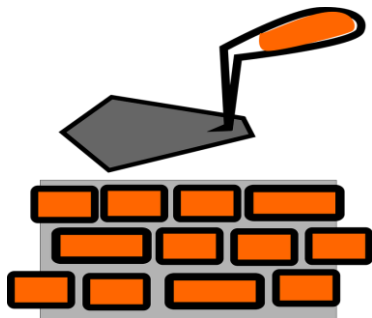

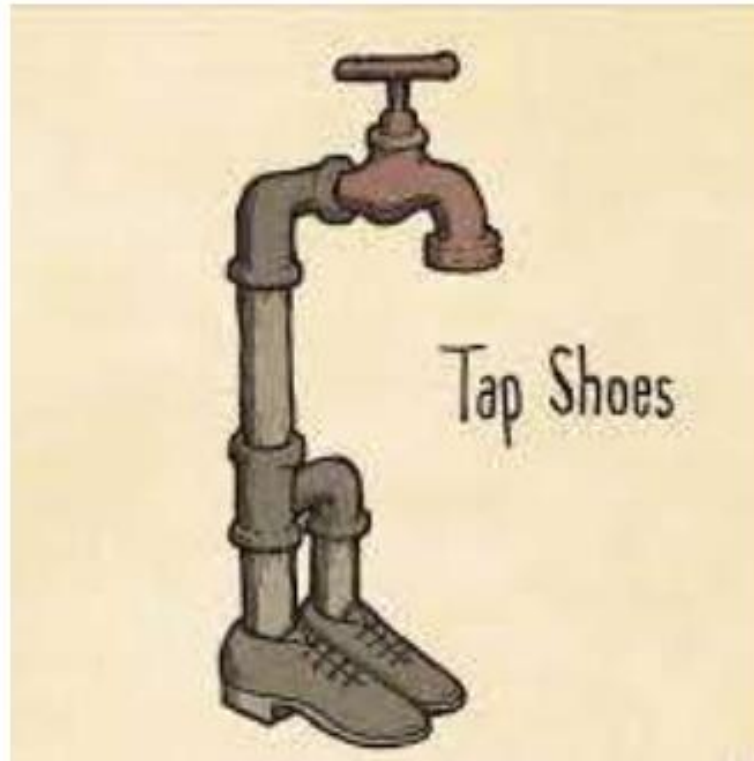
Yesterday's News

PORT WAKEFIELD

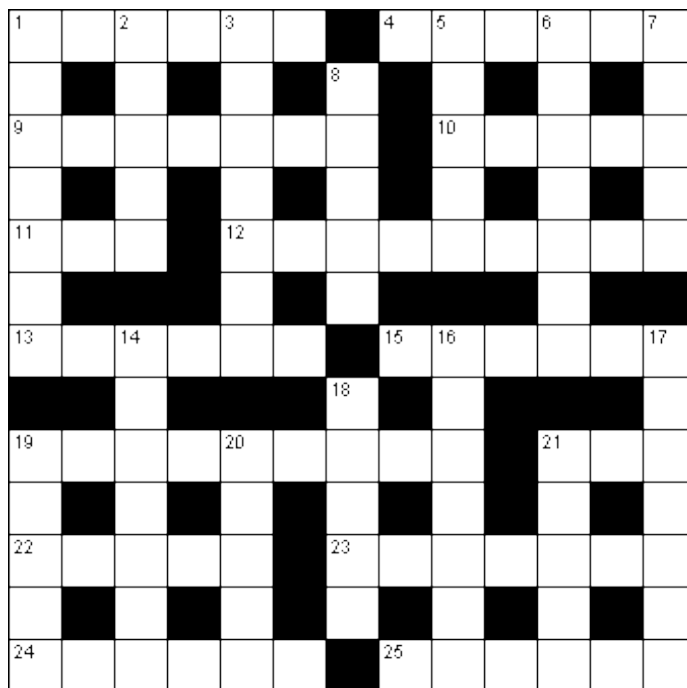
