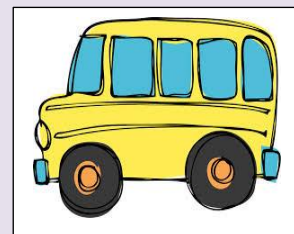

In the Garden 2022 No. 4

So many nice things we see in our garden, food, pleasure, and beauty. I work on the K.I.S.S. principle -- "Keep it Simple Sweetheart." It's easier and more fun that way.

I have mentioned mulching which is so good for conserving water and reduces attacks from slugs, snails, and their ilk. They won't crawl over the mulch as it is not bug friendly. Remember, don't place the mulch up close and tight to the plant stem as this may cause collar rot. Keep the mulch approximately 2-3 centimetres away (or an inch in the old language).

Some say Sweet Peas should be planted by St. Patrick's Day, but it's not too late to plant them now. A little hint to help them shoot is to place the seed in a bowl of warm water overnight. Next morning, plant in the garden directly where you want them to be. An Easterly aspect is a good spot.

In the Veggie Patch, it's time to plant Green French Beans, Eggplant, Spinach, Silverbeet, Garlic Cloves, Leek and Broccoli. In your Flower Garden, Freesia, Sunflowers, Ranunculus and Sweet Peas will give a lovely showing.

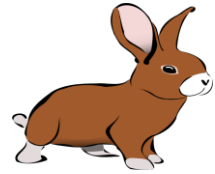

Yesterday's News

The Kadina and Wallaroo Times April 29, 1905



Port Wakefield, April 28.

During Easter Sunday and Monday three inches of rain fell, which is a record fall for this part, particularly at this time of the year. Sunday night's storm will long be remembered for its severity. The rain fell in torrents, backed up by a strong S.W. gale, which with driving force sent rain through roofs that have never been known to leak before. Occupants of many abodes spent most of the night shifting household effects. Gutters refused to carry the volume of water that was falling into them, and drains in some parts of the town blocked, submerging a few residences.

During the height of the storm one man in scaling a paling fence protected with a shovel and overcoat was caught up by a powerful blast of wind which landed him in a rapid moving stream of muddy water. The only trouble that resulted was the blocking of the drain for a few minutes. Out in the farming districts, dams and water tanks have been filled to overflowing, thus removing the unpleasant work of water carting, which the farmers have had to contend with during the past twelve months.

The green feed is springing up in all directions and the rabbits have left their places of abode in the mangroves and saltbushes and taken up their abode with us. They are to be met during all hours of the night seeking green herbage in all parts of the town, being no respecters of persons. Flowers as well as vegetables are visited by the rodents. They have been seen seated in bunches waiting until lights are out; then their night devastations commences.

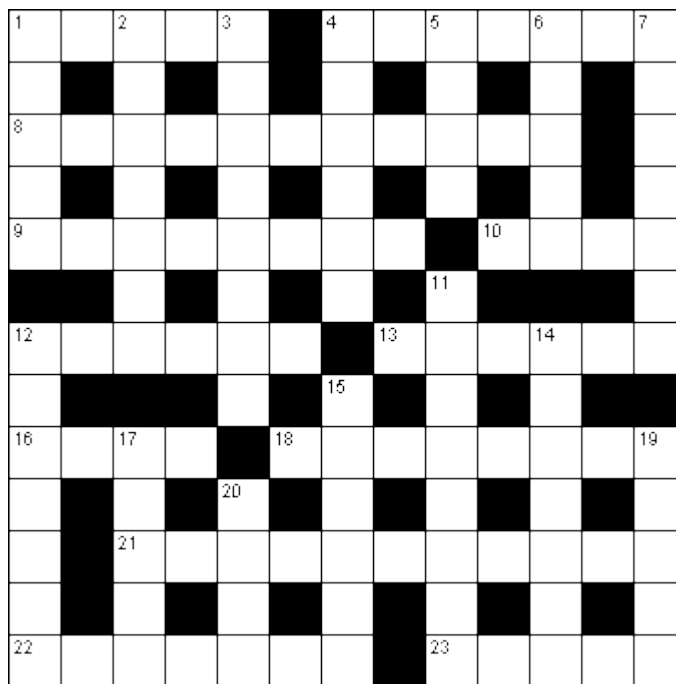
