In the Garden 2022 No. 6

Gardeners have always tried to improve their methods over time, whether that means helping their plants to flourish or even growing something new and different. They're not always successful, but they never give up!

Changing a flower's colour from its natural state was once a difficult task. One day, someone watered the garden with their laundry water and noticed the last rinse of the clothes turned some of their Hydrangeas blue. Really! It turned out the Blu cube used in the final rinse of the washing had worked its colouring into the Hydrangea and turned them from pink to blue. Wow!

Gardeners then tried the technique on other flowers with great success. Red food colouring (cochineal) was wonderful and changed white Arum Lilies to red and shades of pink, depending on the amount of colouring used over time.

Planting in the Veggie Patch now, Broccoli, Leek, Snow Peas, Coriander. Spinach and Silver Beet. Garden Flowers to plant now for spring are, Carnation, Cornflower, Everlasting Daisy, Poppy, Stock, Wallflowers, Antirrhinum (Snapdragon)... Happy Planting!

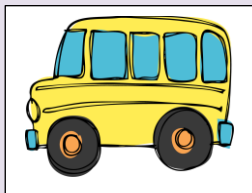

ANZAC Biscuits

- 110g (1 cup) rolled oats
- 150g (1 cup) plain flour
- 120g (2/3 cup) brown sugar
- 70g (2/3 cup) desiccated coconut
- 125g butter
- 2 tbsp golden syrup
- 2 tbsp water
- ½ tspn bicarbonate of soda



1. Preheat oven to 160 (fan forced). Grease and line baking trays.
2. Combine rolled oats flour, brown sugar and coconut in a bowl.
3. Heat butter, golden syrup and water in a saucepan until melted.
4. Stir through bicarb soda.
5. Pour the butter mixture over the oat mixture and stir to combine.
6. Roll portions into balls and place on the tray, flattening slightly.
7. For chewy biscuits bake for 10 to 12 minutes. For crunchier biscuits bake for 12-15 minutes until golden brown.

Rats and Mice at Port Wakefield



**CATS ON STRIKE
GOOD WORK BY FOX TERRIERS.**

Port Wakefield, Feb 19.

Whether the heavy rains of Tuesday of last week are responsible or not, since then we have had to suffer the disadvantages of a mice plague. These rodents are pouring in from all directions, bringing hosts of their friends with them, and taking up their abode in anything that will hold them, hat and clothes-boxes being their particular fancy. Just imagine the feelings of the lady last Sunday morning, when before the mirror fixing the latest in hats, to see a full-grown mouse adjusting his whiskers among the flowers on her hat.

More appalling reports are coming to hand from those residing near the huge stacks of wheat on the wharf. They allege that they have one rat to every ten mice, and numbers are increasing daily. In one house yard alone 130 mice were destroyed one night with poisoned wheat. Cats have gone on strike, absolutely refusing to handle any more mice until they receive reinforcements. Cats of all sorts and conditions have been kidnapped and let loose in the houses, but these have joined the strikers after a few days mice-eating. 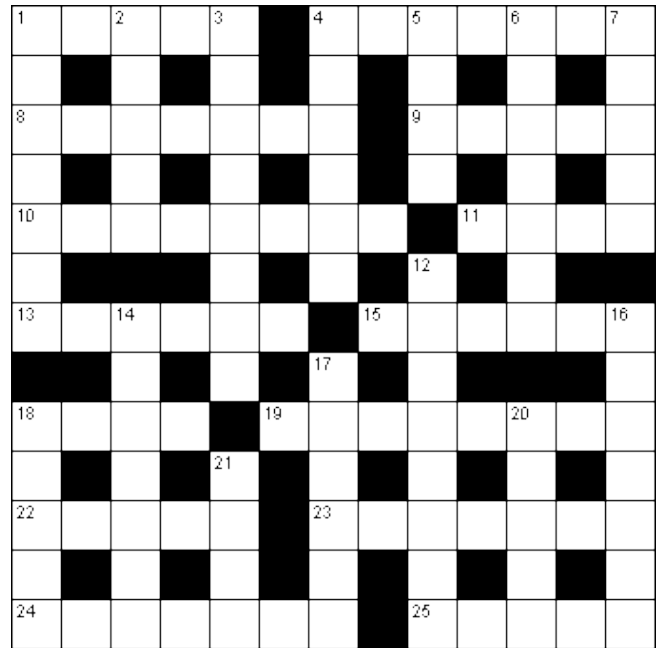
