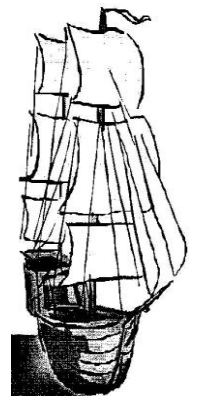

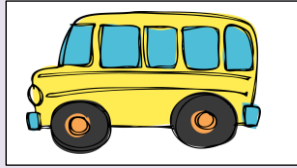

Yesterday's News



Kadina and Wallaroo Times August 21st, 1889

The members of the Port Wakefield Early Closing Association met on Monday evening to present one of their members, Mr Young, who is leaving the district, with some mark of their esteem for him, which took the shape of an address bearing the signatures of all the members, and an album. General regret was expressed by the various speakers at the departure of Mr Young, to whom was attributed the chief credit in managing to bring to a successful termination the closing of the stores here on Wednesday afternoons, which takes place to-day for the first time.

Bryant's Variety Company performed in the Foresters' Hall to a large and somewhat disappointed audience. The latter part of the programme falling very flat, the musical part of Mr McGee's soul appeared to be in his heels, and I would recommend him to stick to his dancing, learn a few more steps, and leave singing alone in the future, if only out of mercy to his audiences.

Our annual show takes place on Wednesday Sept. 4. The Committee have got out a good programme, offering £170 in prizes, and are going the right way to work to make the affair a success.

The executive committee of our skating rink have arranged a fancy dress carnival for Monday September 2, and it is evident that, from the manner in which the members have taken it up, it will be the hit of the season. (Note: The Early Closing Association was a 19th-century labour movement that wanted shops to shut earlier so retail workers could have an eight-hour workday.)

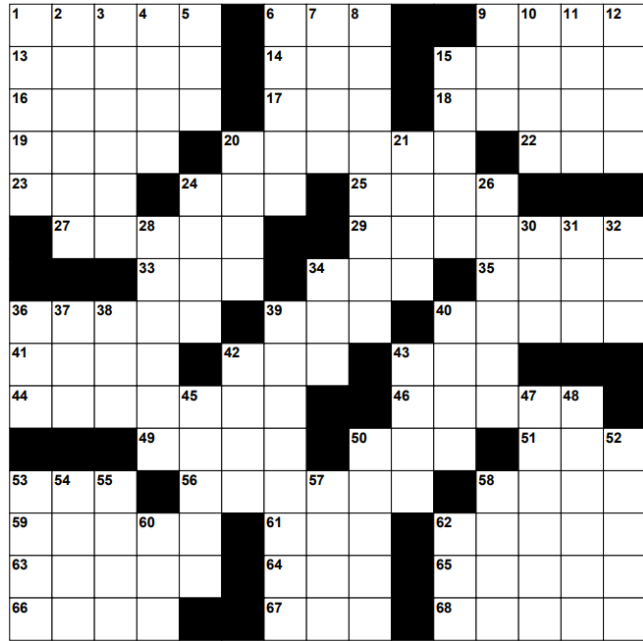

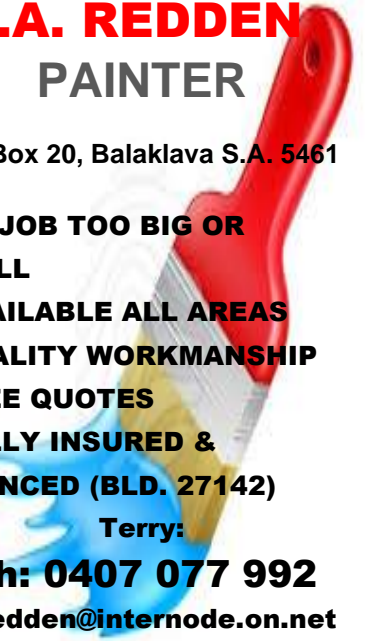
