

Not content with parading the streets with rough music and hideous noises, the larrikins entered private premises, rattling at the doors and windows and throwing stones upon roofs. It is time the law dealt severely with such conduct.

We are to lose our schoolmaster, Mr. J. Fairweather, who has received an appointment to Wallaroo, after about seven years' successful work amongst us. Our young people have found him a much-valued teacher and friend.

A passenger by train, a married woman, was taken ill lately, and on the arrival of the train here was taken into the station. Before the train left she safely gave birth to a child. Through the kind attention of the stationmaster (Mr. Snaaden) a nurse and medical attendant took charge of the case, and all that was necessary was at once supplied for her comfort at the station, where she will necessarily remain for a time.

The weather has been very pleasant for the holidays. Several cases of influenza are still under treatment by Dr. Goldsmith.



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

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
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
