

Disposing of Undesirables

PORT WAKEFIELD-- Three undesirables visited this part last week, but their careers were cut short by M-C. Jones. The first to start operations was T. Leonard, whose selection of language led to his arrest, and a sentence of one month's imprisonment being awarded him in Wallaroo gaol. The same evening, Mr John Fraser missed a valuable rug from his trap, and on acquainting the police a search was at once commenced, and the culprit run to earth in a room near the wharf with the rug in his possession. For this he received three months' detention at Wallaroo.

Next day another man paid a visit to several houses, and by his capers alarmed the female residents, his language being at times vile. As soon as M.-C. Jones was acquainted with his doings, he followed him up to the new town and took him in charge. He was tried the following morning before Mr. F. H. Drake, who ordered him a well-earned three months' at Wallaroo. The three prisoners left for their sea-side resort in charge of a Wallaroo officer on Friday last.

A STRANGE BIRD

A strange bird was captured in the river yesterday by Mr. A. G. Franklin and is the first of its kind ever seen here. The body is feathered not unlike that of the ordinary seagull, but its feet, which are webbed, are peculiar in shape. Its beak is long, pointed, and sharp, and the arrangement of short stiff feathers gives it a fierce appearance. It bites at everything that comes within reach. Although fitted with a pair of good, sturdy wings, it makes little or no attempt to fly but is a splendid diver. It was sent on by train this morning to Mr. Minchin. (Mr. Minchin informs us that the bird is a crested grebe, or common diver).


